We encourage applications from students from a variety of backgrounds (such as communications, English, digital arts, global health, public health, public policy, and international studies). This position will enhance undergraduate students' knowledge and skills in writing, government relations, content management, communications messaging, and outreach strategy metrics.

The person in this role will be a member of the Global Engagement Team, providing support in the following areas: writing, government outreach, publications tracking, scientific paper tracking, website maintenance, media outreach, social media, contact management, and other tasks as assigned.
